4. In the event of any line fence being carried away by water or destroyed by fire, accidentally or otherwise, or removed by the proprietor or occupant, the party whose portion of fence is so destroyed or removed may be notified, either in writing or orally, forthwith to repair or replace such portion; and on his refusing or neglecting so to do, the aggrieved party or parties may proceed under the said Act to summon the fence viewers, in the manner thereby provided, to examine and adjudge in what manner and by whom such repairs shall be done, and their award shall be binding on all parties concerned, and shall be enforced in the manner provided in the said Act. 5 10
