An Act to prevent the undue reduction of the salaries of Teachers in the Common Schools in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS it is expedient to put an end to the vexations and in-Preamble.

justice to which teachers of Common Schools are frequently subjected by School Commissioners and Trustees, who reduce their salaries
to inadequate amounts with a view of compelling them to resign their
charge, and thus enable such Commissioners and Trustees to replace them
by partizans of their own; and whereas, with the view of extending to that
important class of society that protection which they so justly deserve,
it is expedient by Legislative enactment to give a permanent character
to the salaries attached to the office of teacher;

Wherefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:
