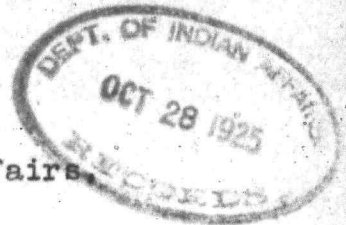

SHALALTH INDIAN RESERVATION.

BLOCKS 'A', 'B', AND 'C'.

The B. C. Electric Railway Company, Limited, has purchased all the shares and interests of the Bridge River Power Company, Limited, and it is its intention to go forward with the development of the project.

In reviewing the records of the Bridge River Power Company, Limited, we find that negotiation for the purchase of lots 'A', 'B', and 'C' in the Shalalth Indian Reservation have been carried to a point where there apparently remains only the payment of the purchase price to your Department, when Crown grants will be issued to the Power Company.

We understand that the three lots in question contain 125.71 acres and that the price has been fixed at \$25.00 per acre, the total purchase price to be paid being \$3,142.75.

It is our desire to complete this transaction as promptly as possible, and we shall be obliged if you will advise us in detail of the further steps on our part that are necessary for its completion.
