 the bridge. The Indians generally  
 were more contented in their  
 appearance, when receiving  
 their annuities, and less  
 desirous to leave the duty,  
 than formerly.

The Indian Services were  
 rendered, as usual, and no  
 disease of a serious nature  
 was found amongst the  
 Indians. The agent and  
 Police agent accompanied  
 us as far as La Riche.

The roads through the  
 north were in a terrible state  
 and the water so high in  
 the Beaver River, it rendered  
 our crossing the same, in  
 rafts.
