Whereas, Frederick Windecker of the Township of Cayuga in the County of Haldimand in the District of Niagara, Seoman, hath contracted and agreed to and with Our Commissioner for the Sale of Our Crown Lands, duly authorized by us in this behalf, for the absolute purchase, at and for the price or sum of Ninety three pounds fifteen shillings of lawful money of our said Province of the Land and Tenements hereinafter mentioned and described of which we are seized, in right of Our frown Now knowdle, that in consideration of the saw sum of Ninety three pounds Sitteen Shillings by hun the said Frederick Windecker to Our said Commissioner of brown Lands, in hand well and buly paid to Our use, at ou before the sealing of these Our Letters Tatent We have granted, sold, aliened, conveyed and assured and by these presents Do grant, sell alien, convey and assure unto the said Frederick Windecker his Heirs and afrigns, forever All that parcel or Tract of Land, setuate lying and being in the Township of Carriage in the bounty of Haldmand in the District of Niagara of Our said Province containing by asmeasurement one hundred and twenty five deres, be the same, more or less, which said one hundred and twenty five deres of fand may be otherwise known as follows - that is to say being composed of The South part of Lot number Lighteen and the North part of said Lot in the Third Concession of the said Township of bayuga, Reserving free access to the Shore of the Grand River, as formed by the Dams constructed for the improvement of the navigation thereof, for all Nessels, Boats and Gersons . to gether with an allowance for a Tow path one chain wide across the front of the said Lot. To have and to hold the said parcel or Tract of Land, hereby granted, conveyed and assured unto the said Frederick Windecker his Heirs and assigns forever: Saving, excepting and reserving, nevertheless unto els, Oursteins and Successors, all Hines of Golo and Silver, and the Accourses, passage and enjoyment, of, in over and upon all maving able waters that shall or may be horeafter found on or under, or be flowing through or wyoon any part of the saw parcel or Tract of land, hereby granted as aforesaid. seal of our vior mee of anadas
