2. The man can be examined at any time after his Quotation, but he should be brought before the Negotiator and the Committee made in his presence.

3. The expense of conveying the person to jail would under Section 71 of the Indian Act 1876 in case the Superintendent General should so direct be payable out of any annuity or interest coming to the Indian or to the Band as the case may be.

4. With regard to the 4th question in your letter referring to Section 71 above mentioned legislation incurred in procuring such information and in carrying out the various sentences awarded may
