I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th ultimo, forwarding to the Department the sum of \$54.25, being rental collected from Hiram Fralick and Jabez Crozier for Locations Nos 4, 17, and 18 Scugog, and in reply I have to inform you that the Lease was for a term of seven years from 1st April 1896, therefore, expired on 1st April 1903, and the rental was paid in full.

If the Lessees desire to retain the Locations it will be necessary for you to forward an application for a further term signed by the Lessees and Locatee, when the amount you forwarded on the 15th ultimo will be credited thereon, if application found satisfactory.


