PART TWO. ARMY. (A) MEDITERRANEAN. FOLLOWING
FROM G-2 REPORT 26 OCTOBER. V ARMY 25 OCTOBER CONTINUED SLOW
PROGRESS TOWARD BARBARA LINE WHERE ENEMY IS EXPECTED TO MAKE
NEXT STAND. THIS LINE RUNS FROM MONDRAGONE 25 MILES NE TO THE
VALLEY OF THE UPPER VOLTURNO THENCE ACROSS THE APENNINES
AND ALONG SANGRO RIVER TO THE ADRIATIC. V ARMY CAPTURED HIGH
GROUND DOMINATING RR 9 MILES NW OF CAPUA TAKING FRANCOLISE
MONTANARO AND ROCCHETTA-E-CROCE AND HEIGHTS BOTH SIDES VOLTURNO
VALLEY AT ROVESCANINA. VIII ARMY ADVANCED THEIR LEFT FLANK
5 MILES TAKING PROSOLONE AND BOJANO. LITTLE CHANGE REPORTED
EASTERN HALF ITALIAN FRONT.

(B) EASTERN EUROPE RUSSIA. SOUTHER FRONT. TO DAYS
G-2 REPORT STATES ENEMY SECONDARY DEFENCE LINES AROUND MELITOPOL
HAVE BEEN PENETRATED AND SOVIET UNITS HAVE EXTENDED THEIR HOLD
14 MILES EASTWARD ON THE WEST BANK OF MOLOCHNY ESTUARY. SOVIET
UNITS CONTINUE STUBBORN ASSAULT HIGH GROUND WEST OF POPOVO.
DNEPR OPETROVSK AND DNEPR ODZERZHINSK EVACUATED UNDER SOVIET
PRESSURE. ENEMY HAVE BROUGHT FRESH RESERVES AND DETERMINED
