G. of some neighbouring Lodge, but if there be none within three miles, then the certificate shall be signed by the Clergyman, Priest, or any Justice of the Peace in the town or place the receipt of which shall be sufficient authority for Officers to pay the several donations, after ascertains he be good on the books of the Lodge.

- 28. That if the widow of a deceased member of marry again, and she pay into the Lodge of her later band, one shilling per quarter during her lifetime pounds will, at her death, be paid to those who may the charge of her interment, (see twenty-sixth Law) vided she contribute to the fund within three months death of her husband. The N.
