TO TREASURERS.

It is very desirable that the Treasurers of Auxiliaries and Mission Bands should place their money in a bank, that it may accumulate, with interest, till the close of the year; or in cases where there is no bank convenient, the money may be sent to the Presbyterial Treasurer quarterly.

Where there is neither Presbyterial Society nor bank, the money can be sent quarterly to the General Treasurer, Mrs.
