The knitting factory of Messrs, Barber & Co., Merriton, Ontario, which employed forty hands and was running day and night, was burned on the third instant, causing a loss of about eighteen thousand dollars. A fire at the Montreal Rolling Mills on the and much valuable plant, the loss being thousand dollars. On the following day a fire broke out in a rolling mill at Cohoes, New York, and destroyed it and other fac tories, entailing a loss of from a half to three quarters of a million dollars. The two burnt rolling mills mentioned above were fire. A flour mill and adjacent buildings, with several thousand feet of lumber, the property of Messrs.
