the present session, and to recommend an early renewal of their falutary provisions.

The experience which you have had of their important advantages, will I am confident induce you not only to make a timely provision for their continuance; but will fuggest also fuch improvements as may enlarge their beneficial tendency, fo as fully to meet any future emergency.

Genilemen of the House of Astembly,

I fhall order flatements of the Civil Expenditure of the laft year and of the Provincial revenue of the Crown to be laid before you; and I cannot but obferve with peculiar fatisfaction the augmentation which has been effected in the latter.

Gentlemen of the Legislative Council, and Gentlemen of the Houfe of Assembly,

To recommend to you a hearty zeal for the public fervice and a vigorous profecution of fuch objects as may promote the true interests of the Province, is in effect, nothing more than to recommend a steady perfeverance in the fame line of conduct that you have hitherto fo laudably purfued.

I fhall therefore only remark to you, that the activity and attention, fo effential to the due difpatch of public bufinefs, will bring with them the additional advantage, of enabling you to return at an earlier period to the occupation and comforts of your respective private ftations.
