Russians Hurl Germans Back Left Over 8,000 Men and Large Number of Guns in Hands of Victors. Petrograd, Sept. 9.—A decisive victory in the fighting before Tarnopol was chronicled by the War Office early today, as the Czar took command of the Russian army. Two German divisions, reinforced by an Austrian brigade and heavy light artillery, were hurled back in an attempt to throw the Slavs out of Galicia.
