CANADA'S GREAT FUTURE. Eminent British Financier Thinks Lot of Cash Can Be Made in Canada. Montreal, March 27.—Sir P. Vincent, the eminent British financier, who has been in Canada for some time, has said from New York for England. Before leaving he said: "I was surprised when I learned three months ago, to find that the financial condition had not had more apparent and far-reaching results. Instead, I found the west absolutely flourishing, and New York affected in a trifling way. This merely proved how sound and stable are the commercial and industrial pillars of this nation."
