This is a very long business. First here are the copper wires-forming the conductor of electricity-which are covered with four distinct coatings of guttapercha. Over this are wound ic tape is used where attacks from nsects are feared. Then come two lavers of Russian hemp. After this mes a covering of steel wire. And nixture of pitch and gutta-percha. The average rate of cable-making is three miles a day from each set of machines. or, say twenty miles a day from the whole factory. The cable near the hore is protected by additional thickses of steel wire to prevent injury

As fast as the cable is made it is coiled down in immense tanks of water and tested continually to see if its electrical condition is perfect When complete, the cable is coiled away on board the ship that is to l
