## SAILORS FIGHT CHINESE; BRITISH SUBJECT SLAIN

**Situation in Far East Grows Acute As Snipers Play Murderous Fire On Foreign Cars—British Marines Rout Natives Seeking To Disrupt Traffic by Digging Up Roads—Repetition of Boxer Trouble Threatens Peace of China.**

Shanghai, June 15.—British sailors today dispersed Chinese who were digging up the boundary roads of the foreign settlement with a view to interrupting foreign traffic. A British subject driving a motor car has been murdered.

The telephone company is employing Russian refugees to take the places of striking operators. The financial situation here is acute, owing to the fact that a quantity of foreign goods has been delivered against native bank orders. Settlement is due Tuesday and default is certain in consequence of the closing of the Chinese banks.

Lawless persons among the anti-foreign element have started a campaign of sniping foreign motor cars. A British engineer named W. W. Mackenzie was shot dead and his companion, Miss Mary Duncan, was wounded Monday night by ambushed Chinese while motoring along the Great Western road outside the settlement.

**CLOUDS LOOMING.**

diagnosed the Shanghai disturbances not as isolated industrial trouble, but as the local symptom of widespread anti-foreign feeling in China, have been proved right.

In the most responsible quarters it is admitted that the situation threatens to be worse than the Boxer outbreak 25 years ago. It is also obvious that the anti-foreign feeling is specially directed against the British.

The Chinese government has addressed a note of protest against the Hankow shooting to the British legation, though the British has no special responsibility for the action of the international force, and the note should have been sent to the senior member of the diplomatic corps. It is perhaps calculated by the Chinese that the foreign powers can be divided against each other. Judging from despatches of the Times and Reuters correspondents in Peking, the foreigners resident in China are clamoring for strong repressive action against the Chinese by their governments. The British foreign office is more hopeful of restoring order by co-operation with the Chinese authorities.

## SENATE LEADERS BACK RELIEF BILL

**Second Reading of Home Bank Measure Is Moved by Dandurand.**

Ottawa, June 15.—Second reading of the bill to give relief to Home Bank depositors was moved in the Senate tonight by Senator Dandurand, government leader. Senator Gideon Robertson, Conservative leader, the only other speaker in the debate, supported the bill. Debate was adjourned until tomorrow.

Sensor Dandurand asserted that the government had a mandate from the House recommending that the depositors had a moral claim in equity. Had the government, he asked, required every bank to post a warning over its doors to the effect that deposits were made at the risk of the depositors, would there have been such large deposits? The depositors claimed that had the war not been on in 1916 the minister of finance would have felt free to put an auditor into the Home Bank. They held they were victims of war conditions. Senator Dandurand thought that probably no member of the House of Commons, faced with the conditions confronting Sir Thomas White at the time, would have judged the situation other than he did.
