FREDERICK SCHULTER SUICIDES.
The Old Man Lays His Head in Front of Conductor Houston's Train.
ENGINEER HAMILTON'S BRAVE ATTEMPT TO SAVE THE MAN'S LIFE.
Frederick Schultzer, an old man of 72, tired of life, laid his head on the track in front of an approaching train on Tuesday afternoon, and put an end to his existence. The suicide took place on the Waterloo branch of the Grand Trunk about a mile from the Berlin station, a few minutes before 5 o'clock.
The train, in charge of Conductor Houston and Engineer Hamilton, was running slowly, drawing two cars of freight, and Mr. Houston's version of the affair is as follows:—About a mile up the track, he noticed the old man crawling up the embankment, and when the tender was barely a car's length from him, he deliberately laid his head on the outer rail, left side down. The train was brought to a stop almost instantly, but the front wheel of the tender had come in contact with the man's head, but had not gone over it. He was shoved off the rail, but the left side of the head was badly cut and the left jaw bone appeared to be broken.
Driver Hamilton saw the old man's action and jumped from his engine to catch the man from his position. But he was a few seconds too late. When the conductor picked up the bleeding man he was still breathing, but unconscious. He was placed on a flat car and brought to the Berlin station, but life was extinct when his body was put into the baggage room. There was soon a pool of blood on the floor, the wound on the head bleeding freely.
Dr. S. Bortly, coroner, was summoned, and he decided that no inquest was necessary, it being quite evident that the case was one of deliberate suicide.

The old man has two sons—Henry, a carpenter working at Shuler & Kellar, and William, a mason, both living on Waterloo-st. Mr. George Ziegler, employed at Mr. F. Snyder's hardware store, was despatched to Waterloo to tell Henry of his father's death. Mr. Ziegler did so, but found the son nothing loath to come and take charge of his father's body. About eight o'clock he put in an appearance, along with his brother, and they viewed the body and then it was placed in Undertaker Suran's care to prepare for burial.
The old man was of the familiar figure in the streets—especially about the North Ward. He was, up to within a few years ago, employed as a hatter, and was of all ages, he has been making his home back and forward with his two sons, and he was also an inmate of the House of Refuge for a short time. So far as can be learned, life was none too bright, so he took this means of ending it. The runner was given currency that he said before leaving the house, that he would take his life, but that could not be confirmed.

He was frequently seen walking along the Grand Trunk tracks, and was on several occasions set off the Company's property by Conductor Houston.

The remains were interred at 1 o'clock this afternoon.
