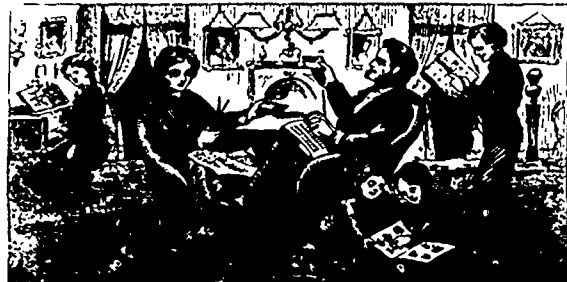
HARTFORD, Monday Evening.
