

- iii. Contemplated change in tarriff rates, duties or any other revenue source,
- iv. Contemplated change in the conditions of operation of financial institutions,
- v. Contemplated sale or purchase of securities or of foreign or Canadian currency,
- vi. Contemplated sale or acquisition of land or property.

9. Section 19(1)  
Personal Information

9. a. Disclosure SHALL BE REFUSED if the record requested contains personal information as defined in Section 3 of the Privacy Act.
- b. Disclosure MAY BE MADE of records containing personal information IF:
- (1) the person to whom it relates consents to the disclosure,
  - (2) the information is publicly available, or
  - (3) the disclosure is in accordance with Section 8 of the Privacy Act.

10. Section 20(1)  
Third Party Information

Definition:

"Third Party" means any person, group of persons or organization

10. a. Disclosure SHALL BE REFUSED if the record requested contains:
- (1) trade secrets of a third party,
