

On motion of Mr. Blackmore it was ordered,—That the Standing Committee on Standing Orders be instructed to enquire and report on the advisability of accepting, as sufficient for this session, the proceedings taken last session in respect of the presentation of a petition, the filing of a bill, and the publication of notice relative to the proposed incorporation of The Alberta Provincial Bank.

The House then resumed the adjourned Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Claxton for an Address to His Excellency the Governor General, in reply to his Speech at the opening of the session, and on the proposed motion of Mr. Hanson (York-Sunbury), in amendment thereto, and on the proposed motion of Mr. Blackmore in amendment to the said proposed amendment.

And the Debate still continuing; the said Debate was, on motion of Mr. Abbott, adjourned.

At eleven o'clock, p.m., Mr. Speaker adjourned the House without question put, pursuant to Standing Order 7, until to-morrow, at three o'clock, p.m.

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What are the names and addresses of persons employed by the Government in the marketing, handling and storage of goods of which or proceeds of which during the year 1910 of the Halifax, Nova Scotia, for Fisheries? (The Minister of Fisheries, Mr. Blackmore, replied that the only other place where such goods were stored was at the Halifax Fisheries Station, and that the names and addresses of the persons employed there were in the hands of the Minister of Fisheries.)

What is the name of each person or partner or dealer from whom the Government purchased certain lobster, the quantity purchased from each and the amount paid to each person or partner or dealer per case and the total amount paid?

What were the rates or charges paid for office, storage or warehouse during the lobster and the periods of time in which they were purchased and the amount paid for each and the total amount paid?

What were the additional expenditures, stating in what manner they were made and to what party?

Did the Government employ any party, full or part-time, to handle any certain lobster for private account?

What were the names and particulars of any and persons' business and did he have the permission of the Government to engage in such business?
