PRAYERS

Mr. Macdonald, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table,—Copies of Final Communiqué issued following the Ministerial Session of the North Atlantic Treaty Council, held at Brussels, May 28, 1971, together with Final Communiqué, dated May 26, 1971, of the Nuclear Planning Group held at Mittenwald, Germany. (English and French).—Sessional Paper No. 283-6/22.

On motion of Mr. Watson, seconded by Mr. Blouin, the Third Report of the Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development, presented to the House on Friday, May 28, 1971, was concurred in.

The Order being read for the report stage of Bill C-242, An Act to amend the Senate and House of Com-

mons Act, the Members of Parliament Retiring Allowances Act, and An Act to make provision for the retirement of members of the Senate, as reported (without amendment) from the Standing Committee on Procedure and Organization;

Mr. Rose, seconded by Mr. Knowles (Winnipeg North Centre), moved,—That Bill C-242, An Act to amend the Senate and House of Commons Act, the Members of Parliament Retiring Allowances Act, and An Act to make provision for the retirement of members of the Senate, be amended by deleting Clause 5 therefrom and by inserting instead thereof the following:

“5. This Act shall come into force on the day fixed for the general election following the dissolution of the twenty-eighth Parliament.”

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was negatived on the following division:
