His Honour the Deputy Administrator desires the immediate attendance of Honourable Members in the Chamber of the Honourable the Senate.

Accordingly, the Members went up to the Senate Chamber, when the Speaker of the Senate said:

*Honourable Members of the Senate,  
and Members of the House of Commons:*

I have it in command to let you know that His Excellency the Administrator does not see fit to declare the causes of his summoning the present Parliament of Canada until the Speaker of the House of Commons shall have been chosen according to Law, but this afternoon at the hour of three o'clock His Excellency will declare the causes of calling this Parliament.
