Question No. 1,036—Mr. Coates:

1. Does the federal government have in its possession or in the possession of any of its Crown Corporations Red Ensigns and, if so, in whose possession are the Red Ensigns at the present time?

2. Is it the intention of the federal government to sell or in any other manner dispose of these Red Ensigns and, if so, what is the federal government's intention in this regard?

Hon. Arthur Laing (Minister of Public Works): 1. Remaining stocks of Red Ensigns are in the possession of the Department of Public Works.

2. Stocks will be reduced progressively as the demand for flags from worthy organizations is filled.

4. Is Domtar considered to be a Quebec company?

5. Which Quebec companies have been subsidized under this Act and what was the total amount paid in each case?
