**Hon. Bob Kaplan (Solicitor General of Canada):** In so far as the Correctional Service of Canada is concerned:

A. There is no Director at Parrrtown Centre but there is a Superintendent, whose name is Robert Smith. (a) Date of appointment to present position: March 19, 1980. \*(b) Position held prior to present appointment: Senior Counsellor at Parrrtown Centre. (c) Salary range: \$28,118 to \$31,640. \*(d) This position requires a university degree, preferably with specialization in sociology, psychology, social work, criminology or some other specialty relevant to the position, or to have passed the Public Service Commission Examination, "General Intelligence Test 310" and possess the experience qualifications for the position.

B. There is no Deputy Director at Parrrtown Centre but one of the two Case Management Officers, William Peterkin, is presently designated by the Superintendent to act in his absence through a Commissioner's Directive issued in accordance with Section 29(3) of the Penitentiary Act. The responsibility may be rotated periodically in order to provide experience and training opportunities to both Case Management Officers.

(a) Date of appointment to present position: March 1, 1982. \*(b) Position held prior to present appointment: Assistant Warden, Socialization, Springhill Institution, Springhill, Nova Scotia. (c) Salary range: \$32,112 to \$36,212. \*(d) The minimum educational requirements for this position are successful completion of secondary school or to have passed the Public Service Commission Examination 320 coupled with relevant experience.
