FOUR SERIES AGAIN FOR BEACHES LEAGUE

Big Outdoor League in Good Shape—Senior O. H. A. Season Extended.

All clubs who intend to enter teams in the Beaches Hockey League this season must have their applications and entrance fees in the hands of the secretary at once.

While numerous applications have already been received, the league would still like to hear from a few more clubs for each series which are divided as follows: Junior, intermediate, with no age limit; Junior, under the age of 20 on January 1 of playing season; juvenile, under the age of 15 on same date.

The entrance fees are: Seniors, \$4 entrance and \$2 deposit; clubs will play all schedule games; intermediate, \$2 entrance and \$2 deposit; juvenile, \$2 entrance and \$2 deposit.

While this league is called the Beaches Hockey League, the teams are not to play in this district, as during the past few winters teams have competed from all parts of the city, and will do so again this winter.

All clubs who have any amendments to the constitution that they wish to be dealt with at the next meeting, must have same in the hands of the secretary not later than Saturday, Dec. 18.

It is advisable that all clubs who intend to use the hockey cushions in the different city parks should make application to the parks department at once, so that there will be no delay in drawing up the schedule.
