





Another great advantage is that the doing away with the opening on the top and the closing of the side slot by the bolt makes it impossible for any rain, snow, falling leaves or dirt to get into the action.

"In case of a defective cartridge giving out around the head, as often happens from reloading or from poor metal, no powder will be blown into the face or eyes, as the solid top forms a perfect shield."


