The following expenditure could not be avoided, and had to be met by the Government in the interest of the Province:

Small-Pox Epidemic. Reception of Governor General.

The compensation to J. F. Grant is explained by a foot note already.

The expense of collecting the Wild Land Tax is well repaid by the amount of revenue derived from the Tax.

By the incorporation of Winnipeg the care of the streets was taken from the shoulders of the Government and is a heavy burden removed as can be seen by the statement of expenditure under that head.
