Cotton Gossip.
Marshall, Spader & Co. wired J. G. Bentley, King Edward Hotel, at the close of the market:

The market was much less active today and reflected mixed views on nearly all influences.

Liverpool cables were about as expected in meeting our decline of Saturday, but 4000 bales were added to the spot sales.

Receipts were very light today, while weather news was somewhat better and a crop report from private sources of an unfavorable character was of some influence.

The market was dull and featureless with no evidence of special activity, the trading indicated a willingness on the part of professional operators to let the effect of improved weather conditions have full force on values.

Weather reports today were much more favorable than recently, the temperatures are still low.

The western belt forecast is somewhat threatening, but elsewhere fair.

While there is no immediate prospect or threat for a decline, the market appears to be discarding extremely favorable influences and perhaps active speculative support is not so strong.

It is fair also to assume that the great activity displayed recently in the spot market will not be fully sustained. We believe operations confined to the delivery options of the new crop will prove safer, and perhaps relatively more profitable.
