PUBLICATION OF MINING STATISTICS.

The proprietors of the *Mikado* are the first to give the public full and reliable statistics of the production of any gold mine in Ontario. These statistics are published by the *Mikado*, a paper published by the *Mikado* in a letter to the press, which appears in an official column of the *World*. This is, we believe, the first opportunity the public have had of forming a reliable estimate of the value of any of the many new Ontario mines and prospects that have been so much talked about during the past year or two. The *Mikado* is believed to be a valuable property, but as far as the public know this estimate is based more or less on hearsay and indirect evidence. We know that a large force of men are continually at work, and that the stamp mill is kept at work. The presumption is that the owners are not so eager to bring their gold to the surface as to what the value of the mine is per ton or what amount of work has been done in the mine the public have no reliable information. That the *Mikado* and *Golden Star* have paid dividends is a fact that is practically all we do know about them. What we do not know about the latter would fill volumes. Neither is it an official fact that the value of the mine is as high as the *Mikado* says, and that there is enough of ore in the vein to keep a 20-stamp mill going for a great many years. Another fact of importance is that the *Mikado* is a statement that it takes a large sum of money to develop a mine. In the *Mikado* every thing was favorable. The vein was of good width from the surface down, and pay ore was obtained from the start. Favorable as were the conditions in regard to the *Mikado* it nevertheless involved an expenditure of \$75,000, in addition to the \$185,000 produced from the mine, to bring the property up to its present stage of development. Judging from the experience of the *Mikado* it is not good business policy to open a property without having available a capital of somewhere in the neighborhood of \$100,000 at least. The *Mikado* Company got along with \$75,000, but it was an exceptionally favorable property. What we have said all goes to show that the publication of reliable statistics of our mining production would be of immense value both to those engaged in the industry and for the purpose of advertising the country.
