ANNUAL MEETING.

The Annual Meeting of this Company was held at the Head Office, Montreal, on April 28th, 1900, when the Directors' Report and Financial Statement were submitted.

Mr. James Crathern, President of the Company, occupied the chair, and Mr. David Burke, the General Manager, acted as Secretary.

In presenting their Annual Report and Financial Statement for the year ending December 31st, 1899, your Directors have pleasure in calling attention to the satisfactory results of the business for the year.

The premiums and interest received in cash during the year amounted to \$68,455.85, showing an increase over the year of \$88,762.07, or 130 per cent. The increase in premiums alone has been even more marked in proportion, such increase being \$38,422.61, or over 145 per cent.

The Company paid out during the year in Death Claims \$2000, under two policies of \$1000 each on two separate lives, but only one became a claim during the year, the other occurred in 1898, and was unpaid at the end of the year, awaiting the usual proofs of death, but was included as a liability due of \$1000 in the Statement for that year.

The total Death Claims since the Company commenced business have amounted to only \$2000 on three lives insured, which indicates that much care has been exercised in the acceptance of risks.

The applications for Insurance received reached \$1,205,068, of which \$1,112,730 was accepted by the Company, and policies issued thereunder to the number of 794; the balance, \$92,338, was declined or deferred as not being up to the Company's requirements.

The Insurance in force on the Company's books at December 31st, 1899, amounted to \$1,707,807, under 1123 policies, the average amount insured under each policy in force being \$1512, and the average amount on each life insured \$1623.
