PRESBYTERY OPPOSES SALE

Congregation of Knox Church Will Not, Therefore, Dispose of Their Present Site.

IMPORTANT WORK THERE TO DO

For a Church So Well Endowed—Resolution of Thanks for Return of Peace.

At a meeting of the Presbytery of Toronto yesterday, it was decided by a substantial majority to refuse permission to sell the Knox Church site. This action was taken by the ministers chiefly on the grounds that there is important work to be carried out in the neighborhood of Knox Church, and by reason of endowment it is in a better position to do it than other churches. The matter was brought before the meeting by a committee report, presented by Rev. Dr. Turnbull. The report was signed by 11 members, and opposed the sale. Rev. Mr. Fritzel also presented a minority report favoring the sale. There was a long discussion over both reports, which was continued at the afternoon session, at which the decision was arrived at. Arrangements were made for the induction of Rev. J. W. Stephen at the Church of the Covenant on June 9. EARTHQUAKES IN ENGLAND.

Two or Three Hundred Have Been Recorded.

There are upon record, as having occurred in the British Isles, between 200 and 300 earthquakes, and these have been attended with damage and loss of life. This was the case as recently as April 22, 1884, when an alarming earthquake occurred in Essex, Suffolk and Middlesex. The centre of the disturbance was at Colchester, where the Congregational Church spire was hurled to the ground, and chimney stacks fell in all directions. The damage to the houses, from the shaking, was considerable, and the people fled in terror.

Another injury was also caused in the neighboring towns and villages, some of which looked as if they had been hurled to the ground. The earthquake of 1884 was completely wrecked. The shocks, which were experienced at about 10 o'clock, appeared to have been preceded by a noise like a rushing wind, similar to that which is stated to have been heard recently. The seismic wave passed from northeast to southwest, and its influence was sensibly felt in the metropolis, and in Ipswich, Cambridge, Bishop's Cleeve, Northampton, Leicester, Worcester, and other places. The extent of the damage done in the County of Essex was so great that it led the Lord Mayor of London to establish an Earthquake Fund at the Mansion House. This benefited the sufferers to the extent of more than £100,000.

Looking back further into history, it is found that the first severe earthquake recorded in England occurred in Lincoln in 1142. In 1271 one was experienced in the County of Devon, and in 1304 the earthquake of the "greatest known" happened in 1318. In 1580 London was visited by a severe shock which brought down a church of St. Paul's, while the Temple church fell. In 1590 there was an earthquake in Dublin, and in 1606 London had another of these physical disturbances, but on this occasion the effects were not so serious. In 1631 a severe earthquake occurred in Staffordshire and Worcestershire. In 1685 a slight shock was experienced in South Wales, and in 1686 the West of England, presumably the centre of the recent disturbance.
