MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

OF THE

LONDON CONFERENCE,

Held in Wesley Church, Hamilton, commencing on Wednesday, June 2nd, 1880 (Seventh Session), at 9 o'clock a.m., Rev. W. S. GRIFFIN, President of the Conference, in the chair.

The 483rd Hymn was sung; and Rev. GEO. H. CORNISH, Secretary of the Conference, read the 4th Chapter of Paul's 2nd Epistle to the Corinthians; after which the Rev. Dr. SANDERSON led in prayer.

The SECRETARY called the roll, and two hundred brethren answered to their names.
