the young people to feel an interest in the work of education generally and in the education of the ministry in particular, and doubtless will be seed-sowing for large harvesting in the years to come.

Ministers and subscribers to the Educational Society are earnestly requested to ponder the importance of sustaining with increased liberality this Fund. The legislation of the Church requires young men to attend college, and yet does not provide adequately for their support at college. Our people are demanding an educated ministry, and the inference is manifest that they are prepared to aid in the realization of so desirable an object.
