140 Minutes of the United Presbyt'n Synod in Canada.

5. As the Rev. Mr. Torrance is about to visit Scotland, resolved further, to request him to undertake this business, and by intercourse with the Mission's Committee, at the Synod and otherwise, to do every thing in his power to further the object of this Synod.

6. That in order to be in time for the meeting of Synod in Scotland, it will be necessary that Mr. Torrance go by Steamer, and as additional expense will thus be incurred, this Synod agrees to pay this addition.

Mr Jennings' amen l-

It was moved in amendment by Mr. Jennings, seconded by Mr. Dick, that this Synod engage to give to such Professor as may be appointed, the stipend of £250, it being understood that he shall have no pastoral charge, but superintend the studies of the students as far as possible during their literary course as well as theological, and when time permits, that he visit the congregations, and advocate the claims of the Theological Institute, and also further the general schemes of the Church.

The question being put, the motion of Mr. Thornton was carried.

Mr. Jennings dissented.
