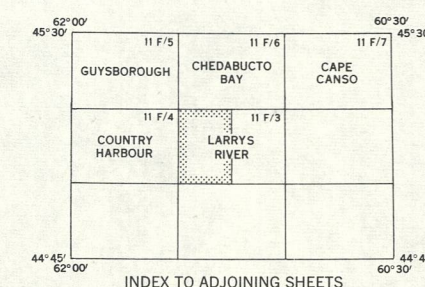

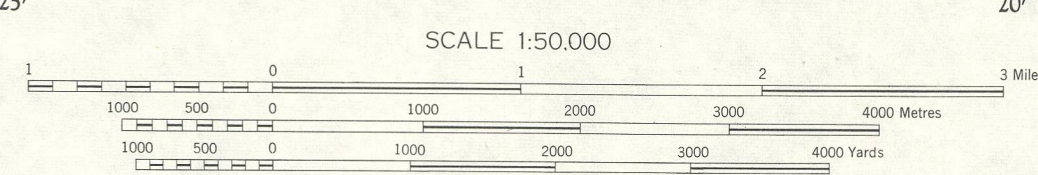
MAGNETIC DECLINATION 23° 07' WEST,
