

FREIGHT CAR JUMPED TRACK

Accident Near Bloomfield Yester

Traffic for Some Time.

A freight train which had been early yesterday morning held up a meeting near Bloomfield at seven o'clock which resulted in holding up traffic for a time. One of the cars left the track and took it up by quite a distance. The cause of the accident was a defective wheel.

A working train was sent out from the city and in a few hours had the meeting again. The accident occurred at 1:30 a.m. and the train which had been at 1:45 was held at Bloomfield until the track was clear.
