and advice to remain quiet and loyal, he refused entirely to do so - I did this, not from want of other means of explaining myself, but merely as a further test \_ Whenever questioned by the Indians as to the inten-- tions of the government towards them, I replied that I was not informed on the subject, but that in case of any dealings, they might rely on justice being done them - I also recommended them to listen to no bad adorie from anyone whatever
