STATISTICAL.

CONGREGATIONS
AND
PASTORAL
CHARGES.

THERE are 50 congregations in the London Presbytery. The number of pastoral charges is 33. 25 of these charges are self-sustaining. Assistance from the Augmentation Fund is granted to 8.

Reports were received from all congregations except Thamesford, North Delaware and South Caradoc. (In making totals these congregations are counted as unchanged from last year.)

North Ekfrid is the only mission field in the Presbytery.

FAMILIES.

There are 3,290 families. An increase over the preceeding year of 246 families.

SINGLE PERSONS

The number of single persons not connected with families of the several congregations is 634. An increase of 181.

COMMUNICANTS.

The number of communicants is 6,882, an increase of 314. Communicants received on profession of faith 469. By certificate 275. Total, 744.

Demissions—By death 103. By certificate 234.

342 infants were baptised and 83 adults.

The number of Ministers on Presbytery Roll is 33; Elders 247; other office bearers 374.

Persons engaged in S. S. work, 666; and S. S. scholars, 5,478

PRAYER
MEETING.

The average attendance at weekly prayer meeting is 2,008, a very small increase on last year, but less than one-third of the membership of the church. (Does not the church's welfare demand a serious consideration of this matter?)

MISSIONARY
SOCIETIES.

Sixty-two Missionary organizations are reported—an increase over last year of 14.
