## DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointment:

Ms. Julie Loranger, Q.C., (49), born in Montreal, Quebec, as Ambassador to Spain.

Ms. Loranger [B.A., University of Paris, 1956; B.C.L., McGill University, 1959; M.A., Institut des Hautes Etudes Internationales, Paris, 1963; Member of the Bar, Province of Quebec since 1960] who was involved in the constitutional review process with the Privy Council from 1970 to 1972, joined the Department of External Affairs in 1972. From 1974 to 1976, she was with the International Telecommunications Branch, Department of Communications; from 1976 to 1978, Co-ordinator, Status of Women Canada; and, from 1978 to 1982, Consul General in Strasbourg, France. In Ottawa, from 1982 to 1983, she was Director, United Nations Social and Humanitarian Affairs; and, from 1983 to 1985, she was Director, Western European Relations. Since 1985, she has been Director General, International Organizations. Ms. Loranger replaces Mr. D. Molgat.
