In compiling the following Statistics, all the sources of information accessible to the Education Office have been exhausted. The first law under which Common School Reports were made was passed in 1841. These Reports, therefore, commence with 1842. Another School Law having been passed in 1843, no Returns were made for that year. Many of the returns are very defective; so that the Statistics contained in the following Table present, in many instances, merely an approximation to the truth. The Returns for 1845 are less defective than those of any preceding year. It is to be hoped, that the Returns for the present and future years will be still more complete.

It is to be observed, that in that portion of the Population which is represented as not attending any (Common) School, are included all those who attend Colleges, District Grammar Schools, and Private Schools. A complete view of the
