

Riding of Simcoe, until its dissolution by the division of the North Riding into East and West Ridings, since which time he has been Presdt. of the West Riding Agricultural Soc. Has also been Presdt., since formation, 1873, of the Liberal Conservative Asso. of North Riding of Simcoe. Contested North Simcoe unsuccessfully, 1872-74. First returned to Parlt. for Cardwell, 14 Dec., 1876. Returned for North Simcoe g.e. 1878, and re-elected at g.e. 1882 and again at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Toronto; Rideau Club.*

MCCULLA, WILLIAM ARMSTRONG. (*Peel.*)

Descended on the paternal side from an old family in Sligo, Irel. B. in Sligo, 1837. Ed. there and in Can. M., Elizabeth McBride, dau. of one of the first settlers in the Tp. of Chinguacousy. Is a builder. Has been a mem. of the Municipal Council for thirteen years; Mayor of Brampton for three years. Reeve three years and Warden of the Co. of Peel; Presdt. of the Water Works Committee and a mem. of the Public School Board. Was Presdt. of the Lib. Conserv. Asso., Co. of Peel, for nine years. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Brampton, Ont.*

MCDONALD, JOHN ARCHIBALD. (*Victoria, N.S.*)

Parents came from Uigg, Isle of Skye, Scot. Second s. of Lauchlin McDonald, North East Margaree, N.S. B. there, 25 Feb., 1851. Ed. at Horton Academy and Acadia Coll., Wolfville, N.S. M., 27 Jan., 1885, Katie Jeanette, only dau. of the late Thos. Hume, of Halifax. Called to the Bar, N.S., 8 Dec., 1877. Was one of the Ex. Committee of the Cape Breton Exhibitions in 1880 and 1884. Is a Trustee of the Baddeck Academy and has been Clerk to the Municipality of Victoria. Sat in the Nova Scotia Assem. from g.e. 1882 until g.e. 1886, when he was not a candidate. First returned to the Commons at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Baddeck, Cape Breton, N.S.*

MCDUGALD, JOHN, J.P. (*Pictou.*)

S. of Dougald McDougald and Elizabeth Fraser. Ancestors came from Inverness-shire, Scot. B. in Blue Mountain, Pictou Co., N.S., 13 March, 1848. Ed. at New Glasgow Grammar School. A merchant. M., 9 Nov., 1882, Maggie J. McLeod, of Westville. Appointed a J.P. in 1879. Elected County Councillor of the Municipal Council of Pictou Co. in 1879, and subsequently in 1880,
