Has been a Special Commissioner at various times, more especially to enquire into the management of different Public Offices connected with the Administration of Justice and Enregistration of Lands in L.C. Is the author of a number of useful works. Created Q.C., 1867. Apptd. to his present office under the Great Seal, 30 May 1868.
