riage, animal or goods, on which Tolls or Dues shall have accrued and shall not have been paid, or in respect of which any such Orders or Regulations shall have been contravened or infringed, or any injury done to such Public Works and not paid for, or any fine may have been incurred and remain un- 5
paid, and for the sale thereof, if such Tolls, dues, damages or fine be not paid by the time to be fixed for the purpose, and the payment of such Tolls, Dues, Damages, or Fine out of the proceeds of such sale returning the surplus, if any, to the owner or his agent; but no such provision shall impair the right of 10
the Crown to sue for and recover such Tolls, Dues, Fines or Damages in the ordinary course of law, if so advised; and any such Tolls, Dues or Penalties may always be recovered under the twentieth section of the Act passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, chapter thirty-seven, the provisions of 15
which section shall apply to all Tolls, Dues or Fines imposed by any Order in Council to be made under this Act.

V. The goods on board of any such steamboat, vessel or other craft, or the animal or animals attached to any carriage or vehicle, and the goods contained therein, to whomsoever the 20
same may belong, shall be liable for any Tolls, Dues or Fine so to be imposed and levied, and they, or any of them, may be seized, detained and sold in the same manner as the steamboat, vessel or other craft, carriage or vehicle in which they may be or to which they may be attached, and as if they belonged to 25
the person or persons contravening any such Orders or Regulations,—saving the recourse of the real owners thereof against such person or persons, who shall be deemed the owner or owners thereof for the purposes of this Act and the Acts herein referred to only.

VI. All Orders in Council made under this Act shall be published in the Official Gazette, and a copy of such Gazette purporting to be printed by the Queen's Printer, and containing any such Orders and Regulations, shall be legal evidence of the tenor and effect thereof
