

in whose stead he or they are chosen and elected, would have remained; and in case of the death or removal as aforesaid of the Chairman, the choice or election of another in his stead shall take place under the direction of the Trustee eldest in years, he giving the notice to that effect as hereinbefore provided.

VII. And be it enacted, That the Chairman and Trustees aforesaid, or any three of them, may, by writing under their hands and the seal of the said Corporation, and they are hereby authorized to nominate and appoint a fit and proper person to be their Clerk, and to allow him such annual compensation or salary for his services, as may be agreed upon by a majority of votes at any meeting of the inhabitants, qualified as aforesaid, held for the purpose of any election, pursuant to this Act, and such appointment, at their pleasure, to revoke and annul, and another fit and proper person to nominate and appoint in the stead of the person whose nomination and appointment may have been so revoked and annulled.

Chairman and Trustees may appoint a Clerk, &c.

VIII. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for the Chairman for the time being, or, in the absence or illness of such Chairman, for the eldest of the said Trustees, to summon and call meetings of the said Corporation concerning the trust in the said Corporation reposed by this Act, as often as he may deem the same necessary, or as may at any prior meeting have been determined, or as he may be thereunto required in writing under the hands of any three of the Trustees.

Meeting of the Corporation how called.

IX. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the said Corporation, to ascertain and fix the proper limits and boundaries of the said Common, and in case it shall be found that any person or persons may have trespassed or encroached upon the said Common, it shall also be the duty of the said Corporation, to adopt speedy and effectual measures at law to expel the trespassers or persons who may have encroached upon the said Common, and to extend the same to its ancient and proper limits.

Trustees to prevent encroachments on the Common.

X. And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Chairman and Trustees, or any three of them, to fix and determine, annually, the number and description of horses, cows, oxen or other cattle, which it shall be lawful for every inhabitant interested in the said Common to put to graze on the said Common, as also to fix and determine the day on which the said Common shall be opened for the reception of cattle to graze thereon, in every year, and again shut up; and they shall give notice thereof by an advertisement posted up, read and published at the door of the Church in the Parish aforesaid, on the two Sundays immediately preceding the day on which the said Common is to be

Trustees in apportion the right of grazing among the inhabitants interested, &c.

Notice of the time when grazing shall cease.
