

BILL.

An Act to incorporate *The Queenston Suspension Bridge Company.*

WHEREAS Joseph Wynn, Robert Hamilton; John Stayner, Andrew Tod, William Duff, Richard Miller and others, have by a Petition, set forth the facility and convenience which the construction of a Suspension Bridge over the Niagara River at or near Queenston, would offer to the public, and have prayed that they, and such others as may be associated with them for the purposes hereinafter mentioned, may be incorporated, and certain powers granted them, to enable them to construct such a bridge; Be it therefore enacted, &c. Preamble.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the said Joseph Wynn, Robert Hamilton, John Stayner, Andrew Tod, William Duff, Richard Miller, and all persons who shall become Shareholders in the undertaking hereinafter mentioned, pursuant to this Act, shall be and they are hereby constituted a body corporate and politic by and under the name, style and title of *The Queenston Suspension Bridge Company*, with power to unite with any other persons, company or body politic, to construct a Suspension or other Bridge across the Niagara River at or near Queenston, with the necessary approaches thereto, with rail, macadamized or other roads, and to connect the same with any road now or hereafter to be made, at any point within half a mile of the said Town of Queenston; and the said Corporation, by the name aforesaid, shall and may, they and their successors, have perpetual succession and be capable of contracting and being contracted with, Company incorporated for the purpose of building such bridge.
