

Duty of the

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall be duty of the superintendant of the *Cul-de-Sac* aforesaid, for the time being, to enforce the provisions of this Act, and to see that the same are strictly complied with, and in cases of delinquency, to cause the delinquents to be prosecuted accordingly. And he is hereby authorised and empowered to require of the Owner, Master, or other person in charge of vessels lying in the said Landing-place at either of the aforesaid wharves to exhibit to him the said superintendant of the *Cul-de-Sac*, the certificate of registry of such vessel or vessels, in order to ascertain the tonnage thereof, under the penalty of

V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall also be the duty of the said superintendant of the *Cul-de-Sac* to give such orders, and directions to owners or other persons in charge of rafts of firewood, boats and canoes, loaded or unloaded, arriving at the said Landing-place, with respect to the place, and manner in which they are to lie, or remain for sale, so as to leave an open passage or passages for the convenient and easy landing of boats or canoes arriving at the said Landing-place, and such owners or persons in charge of rafts of firewood, boats or canoes, loaded or unloaded, as aforesaid, refusing to obey the orders of such superintendant as aforesaid, unless prevented from so doing by some unavoidable circumstance, shall for such disobedience incur a penalty of

shillings currency. And it shall also be the duty of the said superintendant to cause the passage from the water-side in the *Cul-de-Sac* aforesaid, to *Cul-de-Sac* Street, to be kept clear and free of all incumbrances, so as to admit carts and foot-passengers to pass and repass at all reasonable times, without obstruction or impediment, for which purpose he is hereby authorised to remove or cause to be removed, any boat, canoe, timber, drift wood or other materials that may obstruct such passage, at the costs and charges of the Owner or Owners thereof, and to retain such boat, canoe, timber, drift wood or other materials in his custody and possession until the cost and charges as aforesaid are paid, or a reasonable sum therefor be tendered to him the said superintendant.
