## BILL,

## An Act to detatch that portion of the Municipality of St. Roch of Quebec, South, lying west of the division line between the property of the Ursuline Nuns and those of the Heirs Tourangeau and Ware, from that Municipality, and to annex the same to the Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, North.

WHEREAS certain inhabitants and proprietors of that portion of Preamble. the Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, South, which lies to the west of the line dividing the property of the Ursuline Nuns from those of the Heirs Tourangeau and Ware, have, by their 5 petition, represented that the easterly portion of the said Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, South, is almost entirely conceded in small building lots, is laid out into streets, and contains already several thousands of inhabitants engaged in the trades and occupations of a city, whereas the westerly portion consists entirely of farms, occupied 10 by agriculturalists, and that the said two portions have no local interests in common, and have prayed that an Act may be passed to detatch the said westerly portion from the said Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, South, and to annex the same to the Municipality of the Parish of St. Roch of Quebec, North, it being an adjoining rural 16 municipality with which their interests are identical; and it is expedient to grant their prayer: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
