CAP. X.

An Act to restrain the Trade and Commerce of the Provinces of Maffachuset's Bay, and New Hampsbire, and Colonies of Connecticut, and Rhode Island, and Providence Plantation, in North America, to Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Islands in the West Indies, and to prohibit fuch Provinces and Colonies from carrying on any Fishery on the Banks of Newfoundland, or other Places therein mentioned, under certain Conditions and Limitations.

DOEREAS by an Ad, made in the Preamble. Twelfth year of the Reign of King Clause in Act Charles the Second, intituled, An Act for the encouraging and increasing of Shipping and Navigation, and hp leveral Tublequent Ads of Parliament which
