The Deputy Supt. General,-

With reference to the letter hereunder of the 12th instant, from the Deputy Minister of Justice, and previous correspondence, I beg to recommend that an Order in Council be applied for authorizing this Department to sell, lease, or otherwise grant the right, to flood the land in the general Indian reserve No. 1, near Fort Frances, Ont., that may be required in connection with the construction of the dam by the Ontario and Minnesota Power Company, (the area of the said land being approximately eighteen acres) on such terms as may be decided upon.
