Referring to your letter above quoted, and previous correspondence on the subject of moving the
Agency to the town of Fort Frances, I beg to state
that the Duluth Rainy Lake and Winnipeg Railroad have
run their line across the Rainy River at the head of
the Rapids, and it cuts through the Agency house, in
fact it strikes the front door, you will therefore
see that the agency will have to be moved in a short
time, and if we have to build it should be started at
once, otherwise we will have to rent, which will cost
about \$45.00 per month if not more.
